

THIRSK AND NORTHALLERTON MARKET DAY DEMAND RESPONSIVE SERVICE

Operated by Harrogate District Community Transport

A demand responsive service is a cross between a bus service and a taxi service, and is easy to use.

Passengers may be picked up and set down in Thirsk and within the designated area. The designated area includes the villages of Borrowby, Knayton, Newby Wiske, Maunby, Kirby Wiske, Boltby, Sutton Under Whitestonecliffe, and Kilburn.

Passengers may also be picked up and set down in Northallerton and within the designated area. The designated area includes the villages of East Harsley, Rountons, Danby Wiske, Borrowby, Kirby Wiske and Maunby.

These services operate at set times and must be pre-booked. If there are no bookings the service will not operate.

Timetable

Monday – Thirsk Market

To depart from the villages including Borrowby, Knayton, Newby Wiske, Maunby, Kirby Wiske, Boltby, Thirlby, Sutton Under Whitestonecliffe, Kilburn, Helperby, Raskelf, Thormanby, Great Thirkleby and Cundall to arrive in Thirsk around 1000 departing between 1200 and 1300.

Wednesday – Northallerton Market

To depart from the villages including East Harsley, Rountons, Danby Wiske, Borrowby, Knayton, Newby Wiske, Kirby Wiske and Maunby to arrive in Northallerton around 1000 departing between 1230 and 1300.

HOW TO USE THIS SERVICE

In order to use this service, you will need to book your journey in advance.

To book your seat please telephone Harrogate District Community Transport on 01423 526655. Bookings may be made between 0830 and 1700 Monday to Friday, and up to 2 hours before travel but a longer time is preferable, Please remember that your travel must be pre-booked.
